

Parent Participation Requirements

Our parents are responsible for participating in the Kids' Cooperative in the following ways

- Attend a mandatory 2-3 hour orientation
- Attend "Love and Logic Early Childhood Parenting Made fun: Creating Happy Families and Responsible Kids." This is a five week parent training program designed by the Love and Logic Institute, Inc. Times and locations TBD. This class requires an additional fee and must be taken and completed the first semester your child is enrolled in Kids' Co-Op.
- Attend monthly parent business meetings held in the evening on the 2nd Monday of each month (September-May)
- Participate monthly (usually 2-3 times per month) in your child's classroom as either Art Parent or Snack Parent completing the assigned responsibilities which are posted in the classrooms. Parent participation is an important part of you and your child's experience. We want you in the classroom. Please reserve the use of subs for illness or unavoidable situations. Parent participation schedules are distributed and posted by the class coordinator. You must be prepared to start by 8:45 am on your scheduled workday for set-up and stay at school approximately 30 minutes after class for clean-up.
- Participate as a member of a working committee with an assigned regular task or as a member of the Board of Directors.
- Participation is encouraged for all sponsored fundraisers. Participation in the following fundraisers is mandatory:
 1. Annual Learning is Child's Play 1m/5K/10K Race(fall fundraiser)
 2. Annual Auction (spring fundraiser) by acquiring (or helping to acquire) donations, serving on a planning committee and working shifts either before, during or after the event. (as per the direction of the Auction Chair)
 3. Additional mandatory fundraisers may be added at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
 4. Purchase \$1000 in the Scrip Program per school year OR work a total 12 hours per school year at Co-op fundraising events.
- Assist three hours for set-up of the classroom in August.
- Required cleaning of the school approximately two times during the school year, approximately 2 1/2 hour commitment each time is to be performed.
- Pay monthly tuition payment and any other fees incurred. Tuition is due on the 1st of each month and no later than the 15th of each month. Tuition is pre-paid one month in advance. For example, September tuition is due

August 1st. Late tuition is subject to a late fee. Returned checks are also subject to a returned check fee. If tuition is not paid by the 30th day of the month it is due, your child will not be allowed to attend class.

- Members must meet the requirements of the Clark County Health Department by obtaining a TB test. (requirement as of 2013)
